You must receive hundreds of calls.

This week May 4th, about 6:40 AM my
time - west coast, I wanted to ask 2 questions.
I dialed C-Span, Conservative line. I was
so pleased, a lady with a very nice voice
answered, she said "There were 2 calls
ahead of mine and could I hold?" I said
"Yes"

Then a man with a not pleasant voice
came on and asked me "What I wanted

to talk about?" "Where was I calling from?"
I said "Gold Beach, OR. I wanted to ask
if someone could see that an agreement

be put on the table after the bombing
stops in Kosovo. An agreement that the
Resources (oil etc.) in Northern Kosovo
be used to re-build the country and
help the people of Kosovo."

(I realize developers would need a percentage)
but at least the suggestion might get
something started in a positive way for Kosovo.)

Your man at C-Span cut me off! My line
went to dial tone. I was numb for
a few minutes. Then I was very angry.
That was so unfair. I did not think
C-Span was filtered calls. I've heard
callers go on and on with no sense to what
is said and your man cut off my call.
I also wanted to suggest Russian army
soldiers be police in Kosovo. The Russians
are allied with the U.S.A. and Kosovo. Kosovo
will accept them where they would not
accept our army.

As of this week (after my phone call to
C-Span) there are now tanks of Russia
being peace makers and doing just what
I was going to say. PLUS May 5

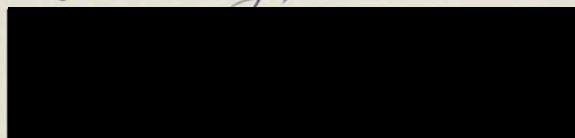
You had Mr. Bob Koprivica of Butte,

you.

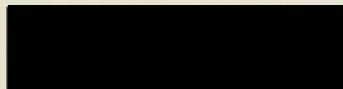
Also would you please suggest to
