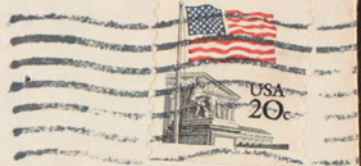
We will also be looking forward to your coverage of the upcoming Conventions in Dallas and San Francisco.

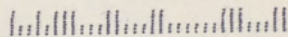
