C-SPAN AIRS NATIONAL PRESS CLUB ADDRESS BY MARTHA GRIFFITHS

Michigan Lt. Governor's Speech to Air in its Entirety

Washington, D.C., September 5 -- C-SPAN will air a taped address by Michigan Lieutenant Governor Martha Griffiths (D) on Saturday, September 8, at 6:00 PM (ET).

Lt. Gov. Griffiths will address Washington journalists during a luncheon speech at the National Press Club on Thursday, September 6.

C-SPAN will air the luncheon address in its entirety, followed by a question-and-answer session with reporters.

Lt. Gov. Griffiths, who is 78 years old, was dropped from Gov. James Blanchard's re-election ticket almost two weeks ago, setting off a wave of protest from women and the elderly.

C-SPAN is available in 50.7 million households through 3,917 cable system affiliates nationwide and around the world via satellite. The network is privately funded and is a public service of the cable television industry.
