We believe that this is a violation of your contract with us. We are interested in the important and many-times controversial issues that C-Span offers through Congressional debates and hearings, speeches, talk shows, etc. We are retired and at home during the day, as are many residents of El Dorado County. It is irresponsible for any media monopoly to deprive its customers of information which will help them formulate intelligent judgements.

We are looking forward to once again being kept informed and challenged by the educational programs on C-Span.
