Since I couldn't find your call-in number
I have to write in response to your interview with David
Brook.

I do not believe the public is interested in sex
stories about politicians. We are distressed by the media's
obsession with tabloid material. Surely what we need to be
concerned about is whether the country is tackling our problems
of education, childcare, welfare reform, retraining of
workers, health coverage, cutting government waste, etc.
Please don't demean your viewing public by catering
to prurient interest in private matters. As a people,
we respected the privacy of earlier Presidents, letting
history judge them in terms of their political contributions.

I agreed with those callers who found your program
disturbingly un-balanced — and David Brook an
