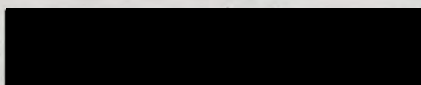

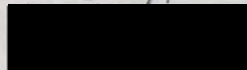
DEAR BRIAN,
