Mr. Lamb: This private citizen heard the interview with the authors of this strange book and then sent (\$5.00) for a copy transcript of the interview and read it through today and as in the interview I could barely follow the incredible ramifications of the tale(s) - in fact I don't even claim to do so, they are way way beyond me and I would guess the other 240 million ordinary American intellects who might try to follow it all and make some sense out of even some of it.
