## C-SPAN TO TELEVISE ASNE CONVENTION American Society of Newspaper Editors -- April 9, 10, 11

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- On April 9th, C-SPAN begins three-day live coverage of the American Society of Newspaper Editors (ASNE) Annual Convention. C-SPAN plans over 20 hours of programming originating from ASNE Convention headquarters at Washington's J.W. Mariott Hotel.

C-SPAN viewers will sit-in on general sessions with editors discussing issues ranging from the "Merger and Acquisition Frenzy in the News Business" to "What Editors Should Know About Sex"; speeches by President Reagan, Chief Justice Warren Burger, Chrysler CEO Lee Iacocca, and Transportation Secretary Elizabeth Dole; and witness a mock libel trial.

In addition, the network's live call-in programs will feature editors from major metropolitan newspapers, such as <u>Newsday</u> editor Anthony Insolia; Norman Pearlstine, managing editor of the <u>Wall Street Journal</u>; and Anthony Day, editorial page editor of the <u>Los Angeles Times</u>. The guests will field viewer questions and talk about how their papers handle the important issues of the day.

On April 11, C-SPAN caps off its ASNE programming with live coverage of the editors' awards banquet. William Safire, columnist for the <u>New York Times</u>, is scheduled to deliver the dinner address.

This marks the third year C-SPAN has covered the ASNE convention as part of the network's ongoing examination of the fourth estate.

C-SPAN can be seen in 24.5 million U.S. households via 2,250 affiliated cable systems.
