Dear C-SPAN,

I am desperate. I am a great fan of C-SPAN, and a worker for the Democratic party as well as the local campaign for Max Vekich (Washington state legislature, District 19, seat 2) and the local branch of the Clinton Gore campaign. On top of this, I am running for a seat as Precinct Committee Officer for Aberdeen, Washington, Ward 1, Precinct 2.

A great deal of my information comes from C-SPAN because of the one-upsmanship that discussion degenerates to even on the best of other news shows such as Capitol Gang, Crossfire and the McLaughlin Group. These are great for entertainment, but the content is usually somewhat lacking. C-SPAN is the best source for information for anyone who is serious about politics.

My problem is that C-SPAN by itself is limited. C-SPAN focusses its coverage on the House of Representatives. This is, of course, a large body, with many states having a good number of Representatives. C-SPAN 2, however, focuses on the Senate, where each state has only two Senators, and therefore, each personality has greater power to help or hinder the progress of the United States.

I have registered my desire for C-SPAN 2 with my local TCI cable system several times, yet there is no reaction. I confronted a TCI employee directly once, and she presented all kinds of reasons why it is impossible for them to subscribe to C-SPAN 2: they can't afford it, they don't have enough channels... (and yet they carried Olympic Triplecast!)

Would you please send a complete subscription information packet on C-SPAN 2 to: TCI Cablevision of SW Washington, Inc. at 819 E. Heron, Aberdeen, WA 98520-6713. State to them in the mailing that it is by my request, if you can. I am desperate for C-SPAN 2, and I'm hoping that my cable system will add it quickly -- well before election day '92.
